



2010 Legislative Scorecard

Welcome to NARAL Pro-Choice Minnesota's 2010 Legislative Scorecard. On the next few pages we highlight the choice votes that came up in this year's legislative session.

The 2010 Legislative Session once again was dominated by the budget deficit. We defeated a number of anti-choice amendments, a remarkable feat given the particularly aggressive amendments offered throughout the session. While one of our top legislative priorities – responsible and comprehensive sexuality education for our youth- did not make it to the governor's desk, we stopped any new anti-choice laws from getting to Governor Pawlenty.

In addition, we protected the family planning funding program, despite three different votes in the House to eliminate it completely. The defunding of family planning programs is one of the best investments Minnesota can make - every one dollar invested saves the state nearly four within a year.

Once again, we thank all the legislators who voted to protect a woman's right to choose.

2010 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES SCORECARD

1. **Fritz** moved to amend House File 2168 such that state funds shall not be used for funding abortions. This amendment conflicts with the 1995 Minnesota Supreme Court decision of *Doe v. Gomez*, allowing Medicaid reimbursements to be for abortion care. 2/18/2010. **NARAL Pro-Choice Minnesota opposed this amendment.**
2. **Fritz** moved to amend House File 2614 such that funding for Saline Amniocentesis Abortions would be banned. 5/4/10. **NARAL Pro-Choice Minnesota opposed this amendment.**
3. **Seifert** moved to amend House File 2614 to ban referrals to abortion services or abortion providers to be eligible for Family Planning Special Projects (FPSP) funding. 5/4/10. **NARAL Pro-Choice Minnesota opposed this amendment.**
4. **Gottwalt** moved to amend House File 2614 to ban abortion care coverage in federal health insurance exchange. 5/4/10. **NARAL Pro-Choice Minnesota opposed this amendment.**
5. **Brod** moved to amend House File 2614 such that abortion providers and facilities have increased regulation. 5/4/10. **NARAL Pro-Choice Minnesota opposed this amendment.**
6. **Dean** moved to amend House File 2614 such that private insurance companies must require an opt- out for abortion care coverage. 5/4/10. **NARAL Pro-Choice Minnesota opposed this amendment.**
7. **Gottwalt** moved to Amend House File 2614 such to ban funding for Sex Selection abortions. **NARAL Pro-Choice Minnesota opposed this amendment.**
8. **Dean** moved to amend Senate File 2614 such that Family Planning Special Project (FPSP) Funding be eliminated. 5/4/10. **NARAL Pro-Choice Minnesota opposed this amendment.**

2. **Pariseau** moved to amend Senate File 2702 such that such that abortion providers and facilities have increased regulation. 5/3/10. **NARAL Pro-Choice Minnesota opposed this amendment.**
3. **Limmer** moved to amend Senate File 2337 such that funding for Sex Selection Abortions would be banned. 5/5/10. The vote scored was on the germaneness of the amendment. **NARAL Pro-Choice Minnesota opposed this amendment.**
4. **Parry** moved to amend Senate File 2337 such that private insurance companies must require an opt- out for abortion care coverage.
5. **NARAL Pro-Choice Minnesota opposed this amendment.**
